The Dicor Power Limited Lifetime Warranty does not cover any shipping charges or labor.

The Dicor Power Limited Lifetime Warranty is exclusive to Dicor Products and is granted in lieu of all other implied or express liabilities, obligations, or warranties.

This Limited Lifetime Warranty is non-transferable and applies only to the original owner and covers only those products purchased from an authorized seller, retailer, or dealer. This Limited Lifetime Warranty covers the manufacturer's defects in workmanship and material.

The following are excluded and not covered by the Limited Lifetime Warranty and void the Limited Lifetime Warranty:

- 1. Products that are installed in or used in an application other than a recreational vehicle.
- 2. Products that are used in such a way that is not consistent with the operating instructions.
- 3. Using replacement parts or accessories that are not compatible with the Dicor Power specifications.
- 4. Improper or negligent use including, but not limited to failing to disconnect the device upon departure from the source of power.
- 5. Failing to ensure that the electrical plugs and receptacles are clean, free of dirt and corrosion and that all connections are maintaining a tight fit.
- 6. Products that are used in a non-compliant manner or outside systems compatible with the Dicor Power surge protectors.
- 7. Damage to the surge protector unit to include burnt or melted components because of poorly maintained power sources, electrical components, adapters, or power cords.

- 9. Any repairs or modifications to the surge protector units by an unauthorized repair person.
